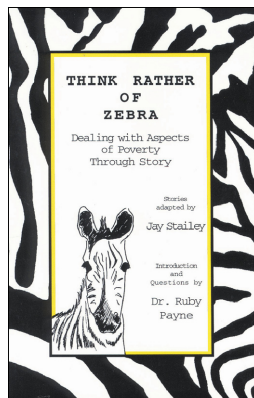


Jay Stailey
