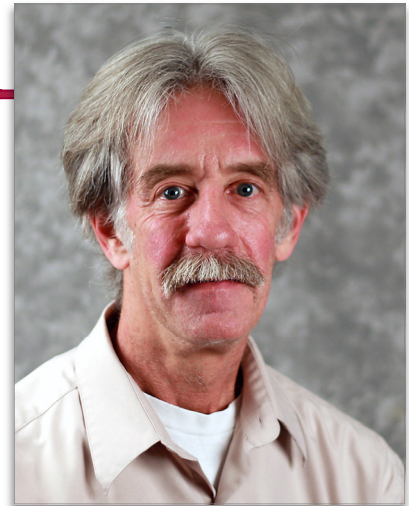


Mitchell Libster

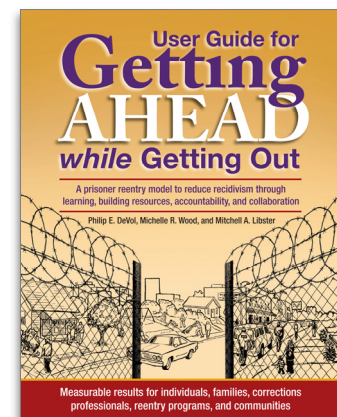
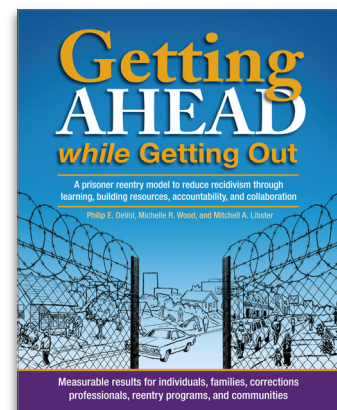
He and his wife, Cindy, have four children and seven grandchildren, all of whom live in the Columbus, Ohio, area.
